Relevant State(s)	Australian Capital Territory, New South Wales, Northern Territory, Queensland, Tasmania, and Victoria. Note: Due to government regulations, South Australian and Western Australian residents are not permitted to purchase tickets in the raffle and are not eligible for any prizes.
